## What is Involved?

- Meeting with study staff to discuss study participation.
- Filling out questionnaires on mood, emotions, trauma, and physical health.
- Answering questions about psychological symptoms you may be experiencing now or have experienced in the past.
- A blood draw.

## Who is Eligible?

Active duty, National Guard, Reserves, and Veterans who have served in the military since September 11, 2001. Deployment not necessary.
